


# Alan Turing



- Alan was a British code-breaker during World War II
- He helped decode German messages during the war
- He was a mathematical genius
- The Turing Test is named after him

### Turing Test: An Imitation Game



Which one is the real person, A or B?
Which one is the computer, A or B?
If C guesses incorrectly, the machine has passed the *Turing Test*!



In modern times, "bots" try to act like humans.
